In 2003 Lorma joined the staff of the Holland Area Arts Council as Exhibitions Coordinator. In 2006 she became Executive Director of the Arts Council, advocating for the arts and artists in West Michigan. She retired in June, 2018.

important information:

Artists must be age 18 or over, live or work in Ottawa County or have property in Ottawa County.

Art Sales: Purchase awards will be subject to a 30% commission to the Holland Area Arts Council and a 10% Ottawa Art Trust for a total of 40%. Price your work up accordingly.

Number of Entries: Each artist may submit up to two works in any medium except video.

Eligible Entries: Only original works completed in the last 3 years are eligible. Traditional print media, photography and digital art are acceptable. Reproductions will not be accepted. 2-D pieces may not exceed 48" h by 60" w , and 3-D pieces may not exceed 6' high x 3' wide. Only work easily handled by two people will be accepted.

Entry Condition:

- Works must be ready for presentation.
- Artwork must be framed securely with a wire.
- PLEASE - no sawtooth hangers. An unframed gallery wrapped canvas with a depth of 1.5" with a wire is acceptable.
- Any works improperly framed without a wire will not be accepted.
- Works must not be wet to the touch.
- Unsuitably prepared, framed or hazardous, or unstable works will be declined.

Art drop-off: works may be dropped off from 12pm-5pm on June 10 & 11 at the Fillmore Complex Building C 12220 Fillmore St. West Olive. MI 49460

Liability/Publicity: Reasonable care will be given to the artwork delivered, but neither Ottawa County and its agents or HAAC assume liability for loss or damage of the artwork while in its possession. By submitting your work you authorize Ottawa County and HAAC the use of your images for promotion.
